

# Immigration Medical Examination: Canada



## UCI, IME, and UMI

### UCI Number

A UCI number is a **unique client identifier**. It is an eight or ten digit number that can be located on official communications you receive from the IRCC.

### IME Number

An IME number is an eight digit immigration **medical examination number** assigned to you by the IRCC. This number is linked to your immigration medical profile. It informs of us the tests that are required, such as chest x-ray or bloodwork and allows us to upload your immigration medical examination results through eMedical.

### UMI Number


A UMI number is a **unique medical identifier**. It can be found on the information sheet following completion of an upfront medical examination.

The type of number assigned to you and the one you use will depend on your specific application situation. You will not be given all three numbers.

## Upfront Medical Exams

### What is an upfront medical exam?

- Upfront medical exams refer to getting a medical examination prior to applying.
- Upfront medical exams can be conducted for the following:
  - Temporary residents: Students, Workers, Visitors



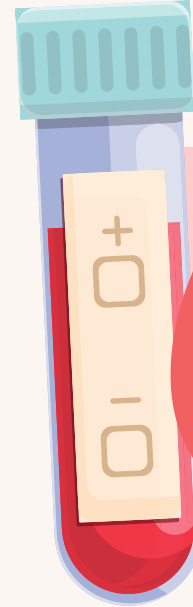

## Medical Exam Requirements

Age	Exam Requirements
0 - 4 years old	Physical exam
5 - 10 years old	Physical exam, urine test
11 - 14 years old	Physical exam, urine test, chest x-ray
15 years old & above	Physical exam, urine test, chest x-ray, blood test



### Blood Test

Applicants 15 years and older are required to have blood testing for HIV, Syphilis, and serum creatinine. However, additional testing may be required depending on medical history.

**Please Note: These are general age-related guidelines. Additional testing may be required.**

IME/UMI/UCI assigned by the IRCC (UNLESS it is an upfront exam)
